•	Cage Liners Or Newspaper
•	Poop Bags and Garbage Bags
•	Wire, Pliers, and Duct Tape To Repair Cages Or Crates If Necessary
•	Make Plans Ahead With Family Or Friends To House Your Animals
•	Is Your Pet Micro Chipped And Is The Address Registered Correct With The Company?
•	Is The Information On Your Pets Tags Correct?
•	Animal Care Card With Information About Your Pet
•	Pet Wipes Or Natural Unscented Baby Wipes
